Homographs are pairs of words that have the **same spelling**.

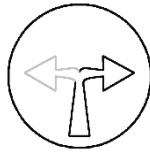
The pronunciation of these words can be:

...the **same** (or similar). For example:

'right'



'right'

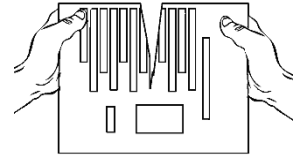


...**different**. For example:

'tear'
