can be proven by research, facts and figures, survey results and other methods.



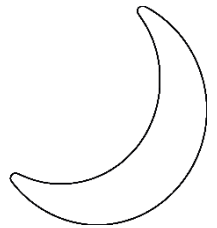
An opinion:
