Alliteration	Place words beginning with the same sound close together to emphasise a point.	Adjectives & Adverbs	Influence how readers feel by carefully selecting adjectives and adverbs.
Rhetorical Questions	Questions that aren't supposed to be answered. Asked to illustrate a point or to make the reader think.	Inclusive Language	Involve the reader using language such as 'our', 'we', 'us', or 'you'.
