It Went Like This...

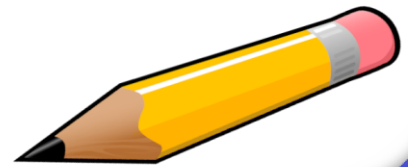
Read the book.

Compare

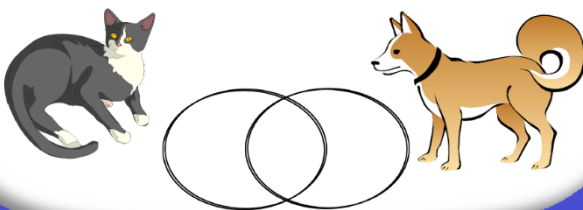
Read the book.
