How many of Sam's friends are girls?

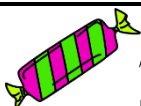

## Problem Solving Answers

Sam has 6 friends. Half of his friends are girls.

**3 of Sam's friends are girls.**

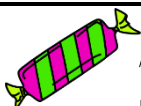


Layla ate 3 halves of apple. Daniela ate 1 whole apple.

**Layla ate the most apple (Layla ate 1 and  $\frac{1}{2}$  apples and Daniela ate 1 apple).**

Allan has 10 lollies in his right pocket. He has  $\frac{1}{2}$  as many in his left pocket.

How many lollies does Allan have in his left pocket?

**Allan has 5 lollies in his left pocket.**

Challenge: How many lollies does Allan have altogether?

**Allan has 15 lollies altogether.**

How many stickers did Kate stick on her window altogether?

**Kate stuck 8 stickers on her window altogether.**
