Climate:

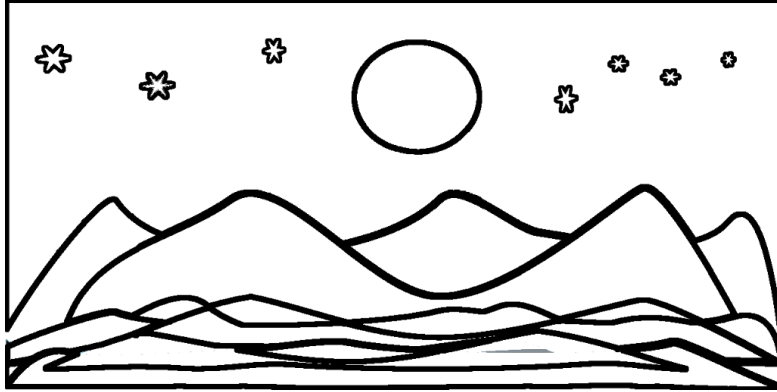
Tundras are very cold and windy regions with very little rainfall. They are covered in snow for most of the year.

Animals:

The animals that live in tundra regions have special features. Thick coats help keep animals warm. Large bodies and short legs helps reduce loss of body heat. Some animals hibernate during the coldest months, while other animals migrate to warmer climates.
