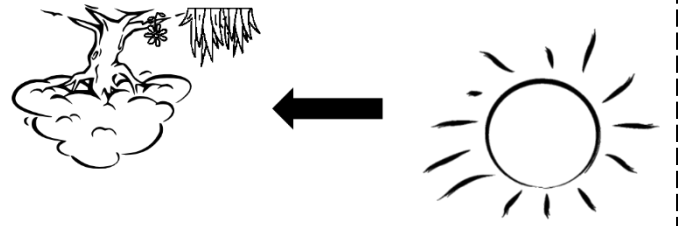
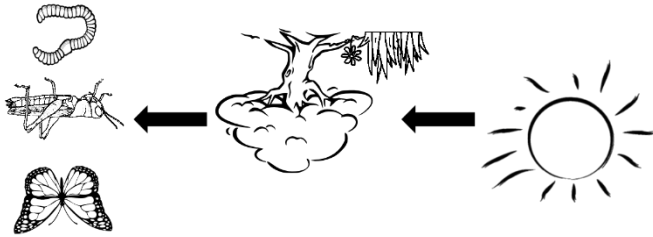


Cut along the dotted lines then fold along the solid lines to make an activity book.

First order consumers are animals that eat producers to get their energy. First order consumers are usually herbivores. The energy transfers from the sun to the plants to herbivores.

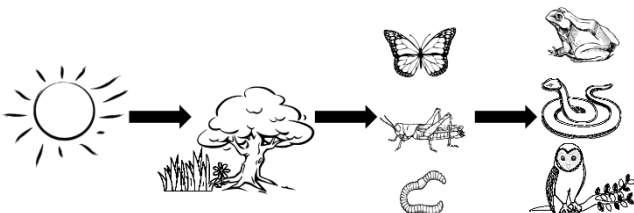

Second Order Consumers

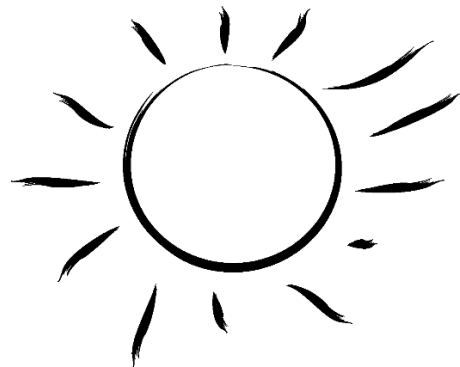
Animals that eat first order consumers are called second order consumers.
