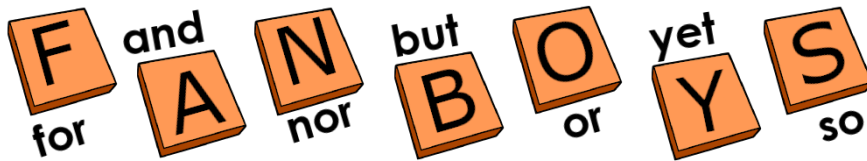


Conjunctions

for shows cause

*The weather was poor, **yet** we had fun.*

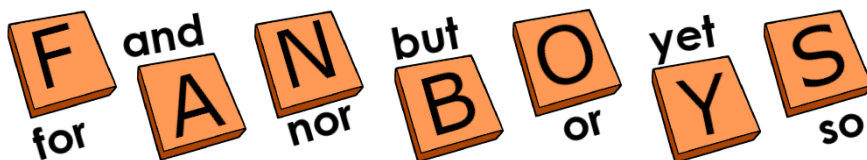
nor connects a second negative
