Charlotte said she likes football.



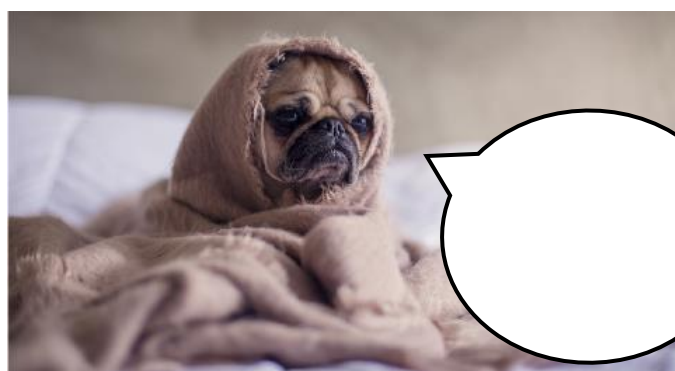

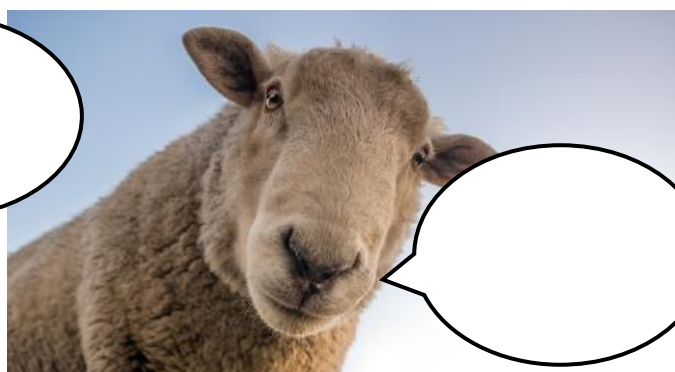
