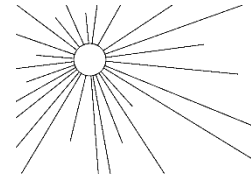


# Metaphors

## Figurative Language

Metaphors make a comparison between two different things. They often use 'is', 'was' or 'are'. For example:

*Sally is a ray of sunshine*



This metaphor compares Sally to sunshine.
