Similes make a comparison between two different things, normally using the words '*like*' or '*as*.' For example:

It's as cold as a snowman's belly

This simile compares the temperature to a snowman's belly.

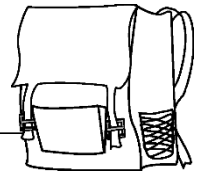


Create your own similes using '*like*' or '*as*'.
