Alliteration is the grouping of words with the same initial sound.

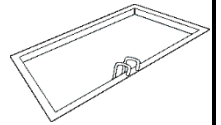
Words with the same sound placed close together can help to emphasise a point and is more memorable for the reader.

We have plenty of playful puppies!

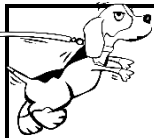
