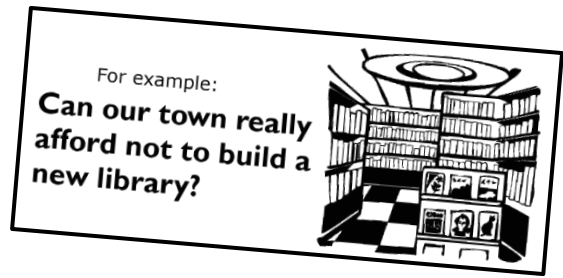


Rhetorical Questions
