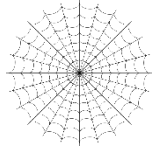


Short /e/ Spelt 'e' & 'ea'

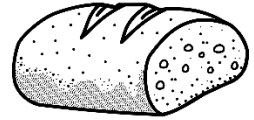
'ea' usually makes a long /e/ sound.
