Second order consumers are carnivore or omnivores. The energy transfers from the sun to plants, to herbivores and then to carnivores. </p>	<p>Producers</p> <p>Plants are producers. They are called producers because they produce their own energy using the sunlight.</p> <p>First Order Consumers</p> <p>First order consumers are animals that eat producers to get their energy. First order consumers are usually herbivores. The energy transfers from the sun to the plants to herbivores.</p>
