



Food chains begin with the sun. The sun provides energy for all living things.



Food Chains

Producers

Plants are producers. They are called producers because they produce their own energy using the sunlight.



First Order Consumers

First order consumers are animals that eat producers to get their energy. First order consumers are usually herbivores. The energy transfers from the sun to the plants to herbivores.





Second Order Consumers
