 <p>First order consumers are animals that eat producers to get their energy. First order consumers are usually herbivores. The energy transfers from the sun to the plants to herbivores.</p> <h3>First Order Consumers</h3>	 <p>Plants are producers. They are called producers because they produce their own energy using the sunlight.</p> <h3>Producers</h3>
<h2>Second Order Consumers</h2> <p>Animals that eat first order consumers are called second order consumers.</p> <p>Second order consumers are carnivore or omnivores.</p> <p>The energy transfers from the sun to plants, to herbivores and then to carnivores.</p> 	<h2>Food Chains</h2>  <p>Food chains begin with the sun. The sun provides energy for all living things.</p>
