Even Chance

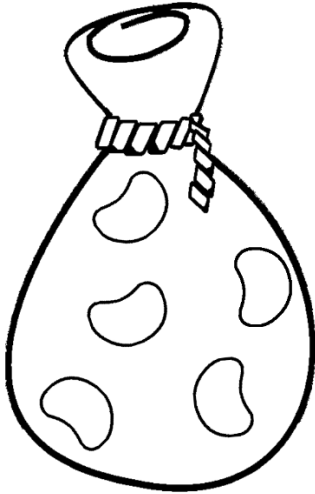


Likely



Certain

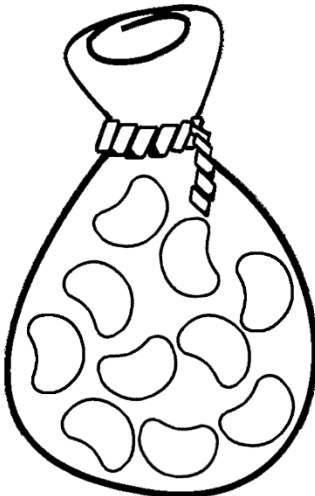
Colour the jellybeans to make each statement true.



Picking out a green is more likely than picking a red.

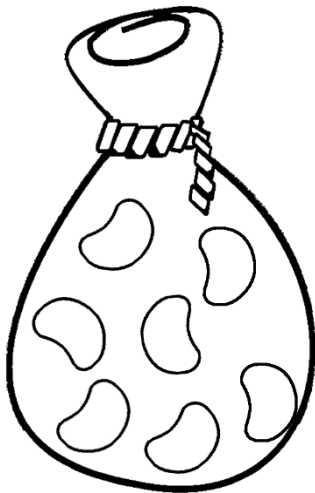
Picking out a yellow jellybean is unlikely.
