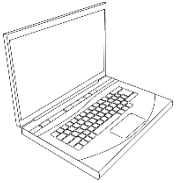

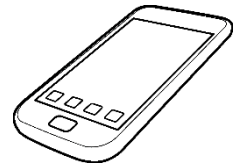
Addition

5. A local artist sold two pieces of artwork. The first sold for \$537 and the second sold for \$393. How much money did the painter make from the two sales?

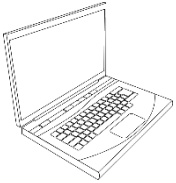

687 saplings

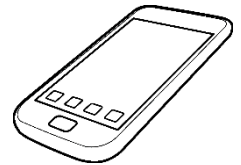
2. Jenny's company fixes computers. They fixed 134 computers on Monday and then 241 on Tuesday. How many computers did they fix in all?
