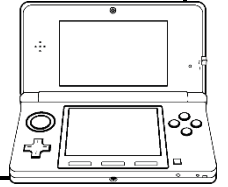

Money (Dollars and Cents)

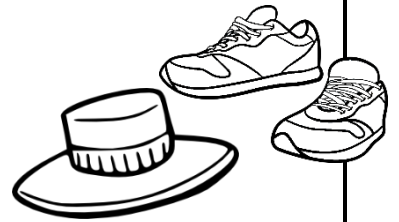
1. Tessa bought a video game that cost \$32.50. She paid with two \$20 notes. How much change should she receive?

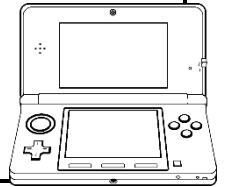


Word Problems Answers

\$7.50



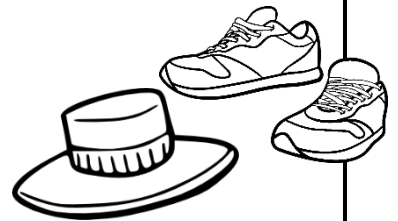
2. Margaret bought some apples. She handed the shop keeper a \$10 note and was given \$3.40 in change. How much did the apples cost?
