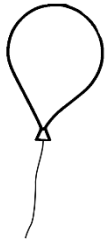


# Word Problems

1. Drew has 1500 balloons. So far, he has inflated 778 of them. How many more balloons are left to inflate?



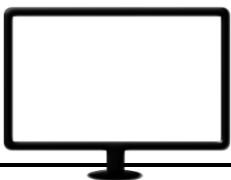
2. The cross-country race was 4 600 metres long. Toby stopped for a rest with 1800 metres still to run. How far has Toby gone so far?

5. The new TV Kate wants to buy costs \$3,679. She has so far saved \$2,053. How much more does she need to save to be able to afford the TV?

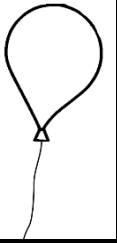

2. The cross-country race was 4 600 metres long. Toby stopped for a rest with 1800 metres still to run. How far has Toby gone so far?

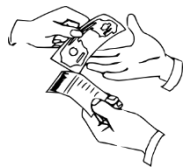
**2,800 metres**
