

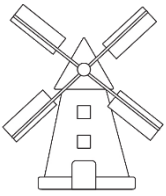

1. Daisy has a filing cabinet with 3 drawers. She places 12 files in each drawer. How many files are in the cabinet altogether?



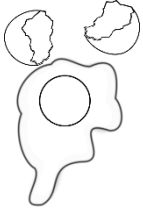
2. Cal wants to replace the sails on each of his 5 windmills. If each windmill has 4 sails, how many new sails will he need to buy?

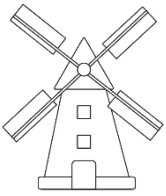
Multiplication
