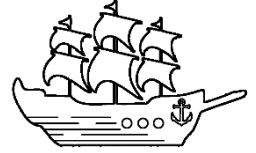


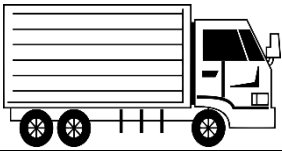

1. A fleet of 6 ships sails into the harbour. Each ship has 7 crew members. How many crew members are in the fleet altogether?



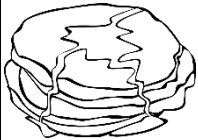
2. Sam needs to buy new tyres for his 5 trucks. Each truck has 6 wheels. How many new tyres will Sam need to buy?

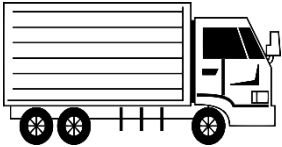
Multiplication

2. Sam needs to buy new tyres for his 5 trucks. Each truck has 6 wheels. How many new tyres will Sam need to buy?



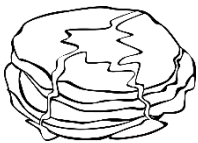
30 new tyres
