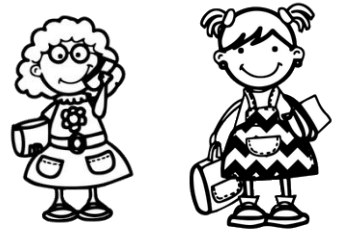


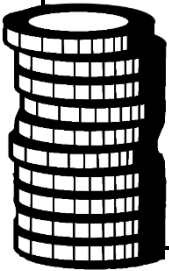

Money (Whole Dollars)

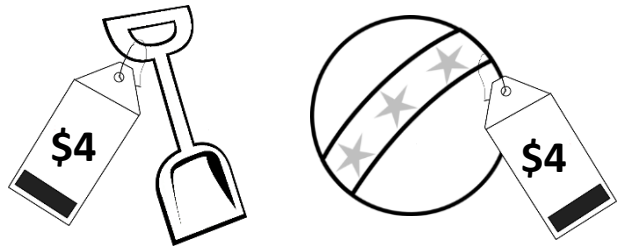
1. A Tammy has \$8 and Wendy has \$7. If they put their money together, how much money will they have in total?



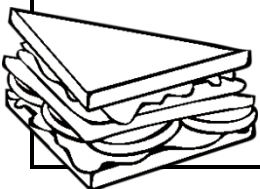
2. David had \$10 in his pocket. He lost \$3 through a hole in his pocket. How much money does David have left?

4. Mum gives Dylan \$7 to buy lunch. Dylan spends \$5. How much money does he have left?

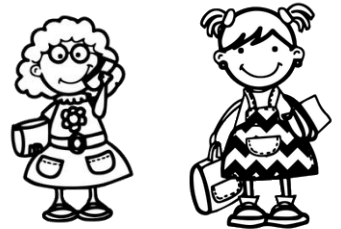

Money (Whole Dollars)

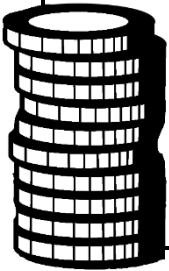
1. A Tammy has \$8 and Wendy has \$7. If they put their money together, how much money will they have in total?

\$15



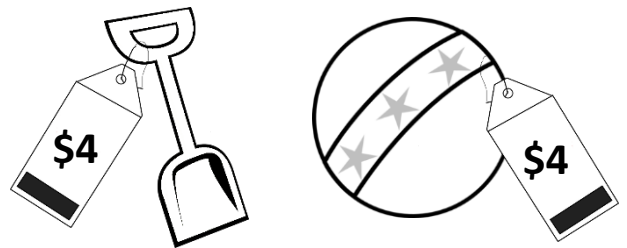
2. David had \$10 in his pocket. He lost \$3 through a hole in his pocket. How much money does David have left?
