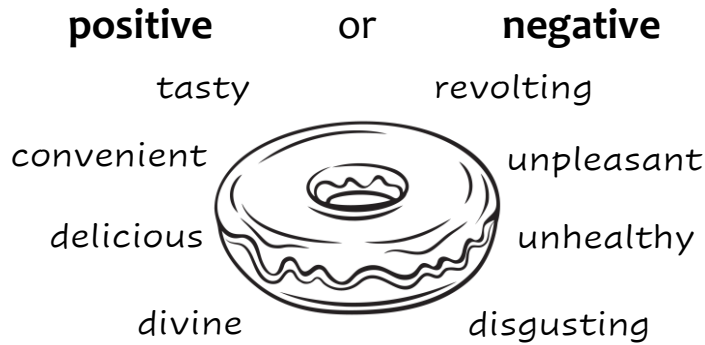


# Evaluative Language
