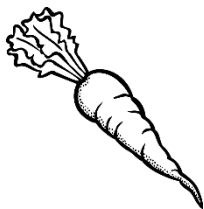

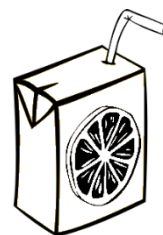
A rhyming couplet is a pair of lines that rhyme. They present a complete thought. Each line should be about the same length and rhythm.
