## Odd Word Out

## How to Play

1)Write your spelling words in the left-hand column.
2) Beside each spelling word, write three words. Two of the words must have something in common with the spelling word. Make the other word the 'odd one out'.

For example:

## SPELLING WORDS

boat
foam
stone
branch

The odd word out here might be 'stone', because 'boat', 'foam' and a 'branch' all float.

## Commonalities could be...

- Number of syllables,
- Part of speech (eg. verb, noun, adjective),
- Objects found in the sky,
- Jobs,
- People who work in a school,
- Etc.
3)Swap with a partner and see if they can find the odd words out.

Make sure you can justify which the odd word out is.
And remember, there might be more than one correct answer!

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
