"Yes, but it is so hot," Meg said.

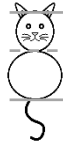
"I know what we can do!" said Leo.



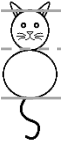

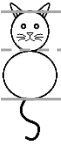
1. Who is Leo's friend?



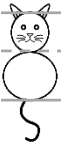
2. List the 3 places Leo looked for Meg.



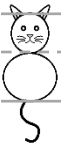
3. Why do you think Leo looked in the pond first?



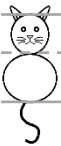
4. Why do you think Meg was sitting under a tree?
