Penny's new teacher was Mrs Shine. Penny sat on the mat with the other children. Mrs Shine was reading a book to the class. Penny had read this book in her old school.

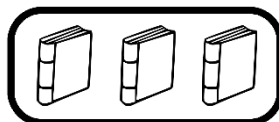
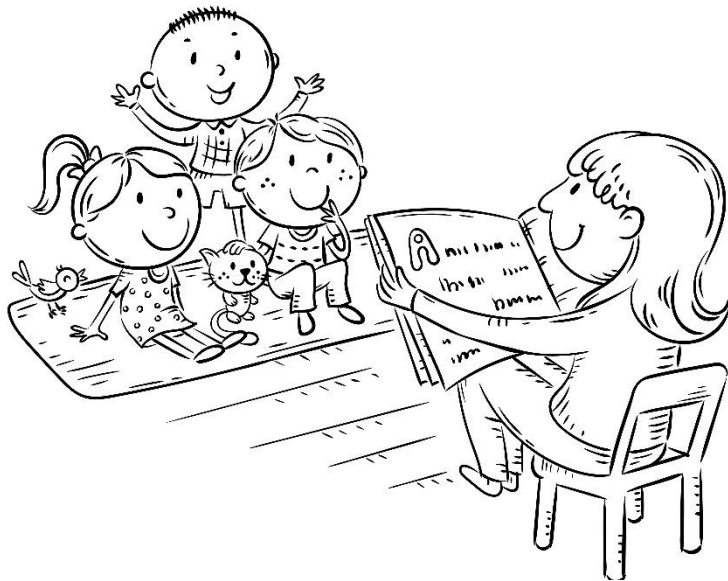
"Would anyone like to help me read this book?" Mrs Shine said.

6. How do you think Penny felt after her first day? Why?

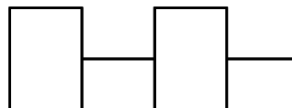
