Mercury

The closest planet to the Sun is Mercury. On Mercury it can get very hot, and other times it can get very cold. Mercury is the smallest planet. It orbits the Sun faster than any other planet.

Venus


Venus is the hottest planet. Venus is close to the same size as Earth. There are many volcanoes on Venus.

Earth




