

How to Wash a Dog

Sequencing

- Use a soft towel to gently dry off your dog. Pat them dry, starting from the head and working your way down.
- Get your dog wet and then apply dog shampoo. Squeeze a small amount of dog shampoo into your hands and lather it up. Gently massage the shampoo into your dog's fur.
- Gather supplies: dog shampoo, towel, a tub, and a brush.
- Rinse off all the shampoo from your dog's fur using lukewarm water. Make sure to rinse out all the suds, as leftover shampoo can irritate your dog's skin.
- Before getting your dog wet, gently brush their fur to remove any tangles or loose hair. This will make the bathing process easier.

Sequencing
