In extreme events, wind speeds can exceed 300 kilometres per hour.	An intense shaking of the Earth's surface caused by the movement of tectonic plates beneath the Earth's surface.	Large fires that can spread quickly through forests, grasslands, and shrublands. They most commonly occur in hot, dry environments, especially during periods of drought.
