Beat the Teacher

3+ players

You Need:

- A recording sheet for each player
- 9-sided dice or pack of playing cards
- Pencils or whiteboard markers

How to Play:

- 1. The teacher chooses a card randomly from a deck of playing cards.
- 2. Each student chooses which place value column to write the digit in. The teacher does the same on their own place value chart.
 - For example, if a 7 of hearts is picked, the number '7' could be written in the ones, the tens, the hundreds or the thousands.
- 3. Once everyone has made their choice and written down the digit on their recording sheet, another card is drawn, and the steps repeat.
- 4. Continue until all place value columns have been filled. Each student compares the number they built with the number the teacher built. The aim of the game is to build a bigger number than the teacher!
- 5. Move to round 2.

Final Scoring:

At the end of all rounds, tally up the points to see who has the highest score.
