

Place Value Duel

- You Need:**
- A deck of playing cards (face cards removed)
 - Game board

How to Play:

1. Both players draw a card from the face-down pile. Each player decides which place value box to place their card in: Hundreds, Tens, or Ones. The chosen box represents the value of the card.
2. Both players then draw another card from the pile. Players must now choose one of the remaining two place value boxes to place their card
3. The game continues until each player has placed three cards on the game board.

The player with the largest number in the end wins!

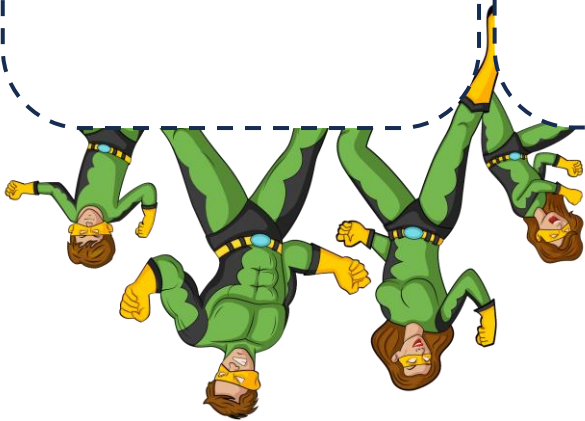
Note: *The position of a placed card cannot be changed.*

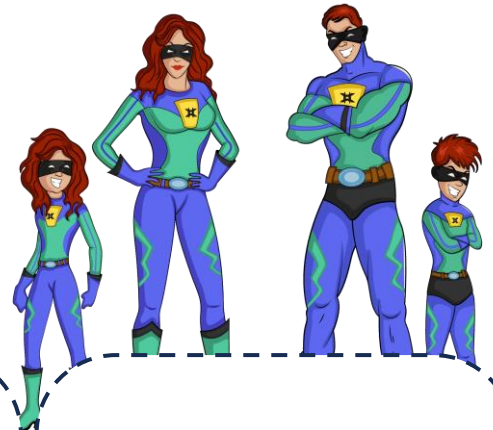
