

Place Value Duel

- Materials:**
- A deck of playing cards (face cards removed)
 - Game board

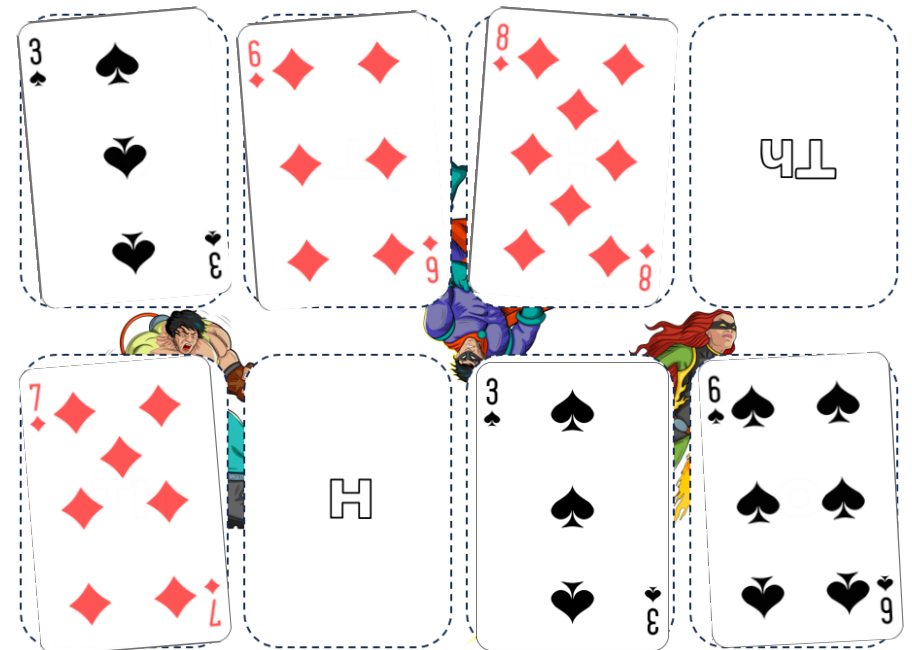
Objective:

Build the largest number by strategically placing cards in the Hundreds, Tens, and Ones place value boxes.

How to Play:

- 1) Both players draw a card from the face-down pile. Each player decides which place value box to place their card in: Thousands, Hundreds, Tens, or Ones. The chosen box represents the value of the card.
 - 2) Both players then draw another card from the pile. Players must now choose one of the remaining three place value boxes to place their card.
 - 3) The game continues until each player has placed four cards on the game board.
- ★ The player with the largest number in the end wins!

Note: *The position of a placed card cannot be changed.*

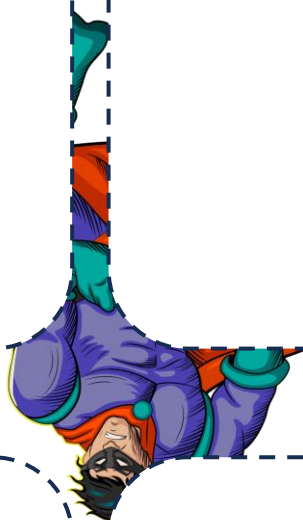
